AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2022-06
AN ORDINANCE THAT ADOPTS THE FEE SCHEDULE ENFORCED BY
EAST PENN TOWNSHIP, CARBON COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2022-06 was adopted on January 3, 2022 setting forth in detail the fees prescribed as they relate to various governmental activities.

WHEREAS, said Ordinance 2022-06 shall be amended to include the following additional language regarding Section IV- Zoning and under Section IV "Variance, Special Exception or Conditional Use"

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Township of East Penn, Carbon County, Pennsylvania, as set forth above, to amend Ordinance 2022-06 to include the additional language as follows:

SECTION IV-ZONING.....Any costs incurred by East Penn Township which exceed the referenced fee will be billed to the applicant. All requests for refunds of unused fees, including application fees shall be submitted to the township in writing.

SECTION IV- VARIANCE, SPECIAL EXCEPTION OR CONDITIONAL USE.....

All fees are due and payable, in full, at the time the submission (including inter alia an application, appeal, plan, or permit request or other package) is presented to the Township for filing. Any fees noted as "paid under protest", "with reservations", "without prejudice" (or similar language) will cause the submission to be rejected and not accepted; and, under such circumstance, the submission will be returned to the applicant. Any charges over and above the collected application and review fees are the responsibility of the applicant and must be paid in full prior to the release and/or recording of final documents.

Engineering, legal and administrative fees will be charged to each individual account. The applicant may request any remaining balance in writing. Any charges over and above the collected application and review fees are the responsibility of the applicant and must be paid in full prior to the release and recording of any documents.

All parts of Ordinance 2022-06 remain in full force and effect.
